



COMPUTER SCIENCE

The following is a guide to graduation with a bachelor’s degree in **Computer Science** by completing two years at MSU-WP and three years at MSU-Springfield.

Year 1 and Year 2 at MSU-WP

Note: Only by taking several Computer Science courses within the first two years is it possible to complete a Computer Science degree within four years. At the same time, the decision to take those science courses during the first two years makes it impossible to complete either an Associate’s degree from MSU-WP or the General Education Transfer Block in the two years. The courses shown below during the first two years at MSU-WP will contribute to a B.S. degree in Computer Science, but the MSU-WP courses will neither complete an Associate of Arts degree, an Associate of Applied Science Degree, or the General Education Transfer Block. The selection and schedule of the general education courses are flexible and are shown below as examples only.
